



AHSTC Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

As a parent of an athlete at AHSTC, I will abide by the following guidelines:

- I will practice teamwork with all parents, athletes and coaches by emphasizing the proper ideals of Sportsmanship, Ethical Conduct and Fair Play.
- I will at all times maintain self-control and know my role:
 - Athletes - do their best!
 - Coaches - coach
 - Officials - judge fairly
- Parents - bring your athletes to practice and meets/matches, support them in their goals and cheer loudly!
- I will not coach or instruct the team or any participant (including my own child(ren) at practice, matches/games or meets; or interfere with coaches or other athletes in any way.
- I understand that criticizing, name-calling, use of abusive language or gestures directed toward the coaches, officials, and/or any participating athlete will not be permitted or tolerated.
- I will empower my child(ren) to be in charge of their activities, to make their own goals for the season and encourage them to share those goals with their coaches.
- During competitions, any questions or concerns I may have regarding decisions made by officials will be directed to a member of our coaching staff.
- I understand that my volunteer efforts are an integral part of the success of the team and I will complete my volunteer responsibilities.

Consequences:

Should I conduct myself in such a way that brings discredit or discord to the Arbor Heights Club or Team, I will voluntarily subject myself to disciplinary action as determined by the coaching staff or Board of Trustees. Disciplinary action may include:

- Parent/Guardian will be reminded of the above guidelines
- Parent/Guardian will be asked to vacate the facility
- Parent/Guardian will be banned from attendance at any or all future competitions
- Parent/Guardian will be required to meet with Board of Trustees and may be suspended from the club for a period of time.
